



WRDA 2020

- Formalized the Task Force's existing activities
- Protects America's investments
- Requires development of priority lists
- Directs the Task Force to use its coordination abilities
- Recommends inclusion of trained volunteers as appropriate

Progress

- ✓ Initial Prevention Priority Species List
- ✓ Prevention Recommendations
- Tool Development <u>Underway</u>- University of Florida (UF) and U.S. Geological Survey (USGS)
- Target of Tool Development
 - Impacts to native flora and fauna
 - Impacts to indicator species

Next Steps

Develop priority lists for landed species:

- Invaders appropriate for Early Detection/Rapid Response (EDRR)
- Established species in Containment or Longterm Management
- UF/USGS expert workshop and prioritization process

Next Steps, Continued

- Conduct inventory of:
 - Existing detection programs
 - Available tools
 - Existing funding
- Development of a work plan to provide schedule of activities and milestones
