Powers (authorities)

- Establish advisory bodies
- Advice and input from any interested, knowledgeable, or affected party

# Science Coordination Group (SCG)

#### Duties

...established to coordinate the scientific aspects of policies, strategies, plans, programs, projects, activities, and priorities, pursuant to section 528(f)(2)(B) of the Act, and to coordinate scientific and other research associated with the restoration of the South Florida ecosystem, pursuant to section 528(f)(2)(G) of the Act.

### Reporting:

- Science Coordination Plan: Tracks and coordinates programmatic level science and other research, identifies programmatic level priority science needs and gaps, and informs management decisions (2012)
- Invasive Exotic Species Strategic Action Framework (2020)
- System-wide Ecological Indicators Report

### SCG - Mechanisms for Coordination

- Joint WG/SCG meetings
- Production of science and restoration reports
- Convenes scientific workshops on specific topics
- Participation in independent scientific meetings and conferences
- Develops scientific tools (i.e., system-wide ecological indicators) to address restoration issues and questions
- Utilizes independent scientific panels and experts to review products
- Reviews independently developed scientific and policy reports to remain current on restoration science, planning, and policy
