Background

Workshop Format


- This workshop is designed to:

 - Public Comment: Oral comments can be provided at the conclusion of the workshop with the Raise Hand feature.


Q&A Session via Chat

- In your controls at the bottom of the Zoom window, click or tap the Chat icon.

Q&A Session via Chat

- The workshop moderators will then read your questions to the panelists.
- The moderators may combine similar questions in order to get to as many questions as possible in the time allowed.
- The moderators will also try to pose any follow up questions in a timely manner.



Public Comment via Raise Hand

- At the beginning of the public comment period, click the Raise Hand icon at the bottom of your screen if you'd like to speak.
- The workshop moderators will be notified that you've raised your hand.
