DESCRIPTION:

This memorandum provides Project Managers and Project Delivery Team members the definition of project management regions for the South Florida Ecosystem.

GUIDANCE:

To assist in the effective and efficient management of the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan (CERP), the project being implemented under this program between the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) will be geographically categorized into management regions.

APPLICATION:

Effective the date of this memorandum, all projects managed under the CERP Program will be assigned to one of the nine South Florida Program Management Regions depicted on Figure 1. Table 1 reflects the assignment of the projects currently identified under this program to one of the South Florida Program Management Regions.



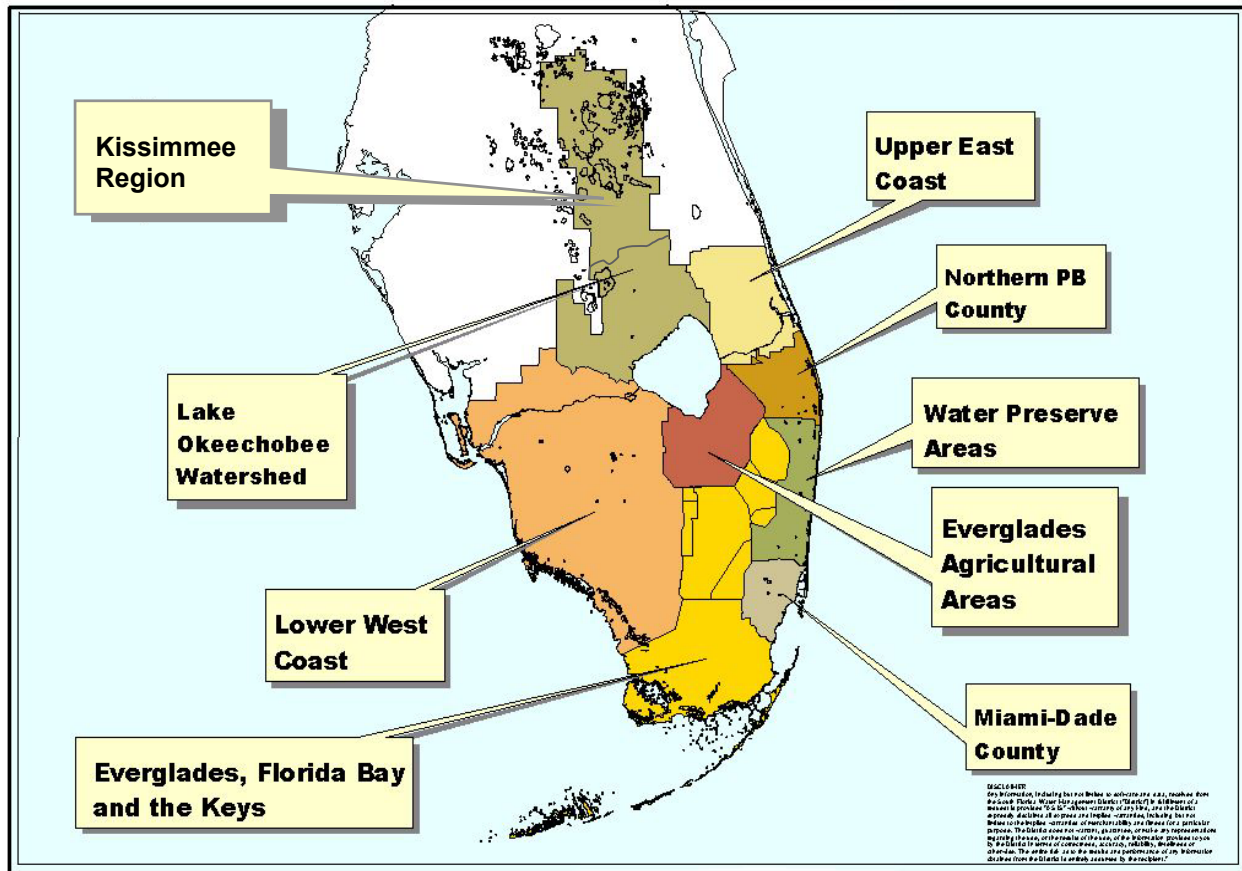
